This happened in the 3' area but she feels it is happening in the 5' also. Travis tried sanding the bad spots prior to painting but they seem to be worse now with the water in. Discussion held: It was decided we could either rope off the entire 3' area for now or require shoes to avoid any more injuries. In the meantime, everyone can think of some creative temporary fixes.
