

ORDINANCE NO. 09-23

AN ORDINANCE TO SET MONTHLY METERED SEWER RATES TO USERS WHO RESIDE OUTSIDE THE VILLAGE OF THORNVILLE, OHIO CORPORATION LIMITS.

WHEREAS, Ohio law authorizes a municipal corporation to charge users outside its corporation limits a higher rate, reasonably determined to help recover capital outlay, than the rates charged to users within the corporation for water service; and

WHEREAS, it having been reasonably determined that such a rate structure is necessary to help recover capital outlay by the Village of Thornville.

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Thornville, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That users of the village water service whose property is located outside of the village's corporation limits and who are not serviced by Northern Perry County Water & Waste Water, shall be charged at a rate that is twice the rate of users located within the village corporation limits, as well as their proportional share of the debt service charge which is determined by the total number of connections.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
