

ORDINANCE NO. 11-10

AN ORDINANCE REVOKING SECTION 18 OF ORDINANCE
NO. 10-16 FOR THE VILLAGE OF THORNVILLE, OHIO

WHEREAS, on Aug. 22nd, the Council of the Village of Thornville, Ohio, passed Ordinance Number 10-16. Section 18 of such Ordinance stated that the hourly pay for the Records Retention Secretary shall be Seven Dollars and fifty-two cents (\$7.52) per hour paid monthly, up to \$2,000.00 per year; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that it is necessary that the Village change the hourly rate of the Records Retention Secretary in order to better serve the general health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THORNVILLE, OHIO, THAT:

Section I:

The Village Council hereby revokes Section 18 of Ordinance 10-16, a section of an Ordinance establishing an hourly rate of pay for the Records Retention Secretary.

Section II:

This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time provided by the laws of the State of Ohio.
