

ORDINANCE: 12-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 12-10, SECTION 2 (VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR YEARLY SALARY) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville recently adopted Ordinance No. 12-10, and thereby established the compensation and pay schedules for certain positions within the Village of Thornville, including the village administrator; and

WHEREAS, since adopting Ordinance No. 12-10, the Village of Thornville hired a new village administrator; and

WHEREAS, the new village administrator requested his salary, as set forth in Ordinance No. 12-10, be paid bi-weekly rather than monthly; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville believes this request is reasonable and wants to accommodate it; and

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: Section 2 of Ordinance No. 12-10, passed by Council on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of May 2012, shall be and is hereby amended to read as follows:


SECTION 2: The yearly salary of the Village Administrator shall be within the following range: \$35,000 - \$45,000, depending upon the individual's knowledge, experience, and qualifications, paid in equal bi-weekly installments.

SECTION 2: All other Sections and Sub-Sections of Ordinance No. 12-10 shall remain unchanged, in full force, effective, and enforceable


SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that the Village needs to establish this bi-weekly pay schedule immediately so that the village administrator can be paid accordingly for the work he performs. Wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the required affirmative votes of Council, it shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage by Council.
