

ORDINANCE: 12-18

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 12-13 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, in August 2012, Council for the Village of Thornville adopted Ordinance 12-13 and amended the 2012 Annual Appropriation Ordinance (Ordinance 11-18); and

WHEREAS, since Council adopted Ordinance 12-13, a clerical mistake was discovered; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville now wants to correct the clerical mistake and amend Ordinance 12-13, Section 1.

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: Section 1 of Ordinance 12-13, passed on the 27th day of July 2012 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The 2012 Annual Appropriations of the Village of Thornville, as established by Ordinance 11-18, shall hereby be amended and additional amounts shall be appropriated, as recommended by the Fiscal Officer, as follows:

SECTION 2: All other original and amended sections and sub-sections of Ordinance 12-13 and Ordinance 11-18 shall remain unchanged, in effect, and enforceable.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Village of Thornville which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 5: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

SECTION 6: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that Council needs to provide the necessary funds to meet requirements and obligations.. Wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the required affirmative votes of Council, it shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage by Council.
