ORDINANCE: 13-04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2013 PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE NO. 12-20, BY INCREASING CERTAIN FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville has become aware that its 2013 Permanent Appropriate Ordinance had an error in it; and

WHEREAS, because of an error in the original spreadsheet, the Police Department's General Fund subtotal (\$14,660.00) was not included in the overall total appropriated amount; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville now wants to correct this error.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: The 2013 Permanent Appropriations shall be amended by increasing the General Fund in amount of \$14,660.00, thereby adjusting the 2013 appropriations for the General Fund to \$253,175.00 and the 2013 Permanent Appropriations Total to \$1,463,645.00.

SECTION 2: Distribution of the increased amounts shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 5: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Greenfield and the further reason that Council needs to provide the necessary funds to meet requirements and obligations. Wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council
