ORDINANCE NO. 13-08



AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING ON CRAIG DRIVE IN THE VILLAGE OF THORNVILLE, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville has examined carefully the on-street and/or street right-of-way motor vehicle parking on Craig Drive, and the Village's need to restrict such parking; and

WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Thornville, in order to provide safer streets, free movement, access of emergency vehicles, and better lines of sight believes it is necessary to prohibit parking on Craig Drive in the Village of Thornville.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, **BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio that:

- SECTION 1: No person shall permit or cause the stopping, standing, or parking of a motor vehicle on either side of Craig Drive, or within the Craig Drive right-of-way, in the Village of Thornville, Ohio.
- SECTION 2: Council for the Village of Thornville hereby authorizes the Village Administrator, or her designee, to install "No Parking" signs at, near, or along Craig Drive.
- SECTION 3: Whoever violates Section 1 shall be punished in accordance with Village of Thornville Codified Ordinance Sections 351.03(a)(14) and 351.03(b).
- SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.
- SECTION 5: All prior Ordinances, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereto.
- SECTION 6: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that the Village needs to establish this no parking zone immediately. Wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the required affirmative votes of Council, it shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage by Council.
