

ORDINANCE NO. 19-03

ADOPTED: March 25, 2019

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING COREY HOOVER'S RATE OF PAY TO \$18.11/HR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Corey Hoover works for the Village of Thornville and currently is being paid as a full-time General Laborer; and

WHEREAS, since starting his employment with the Village of Thornville, Corey Hoover has taken the initiative and obtained his Waste Water I License. As such, Mr. Hoover has started the process to becoming a fully licensed Sewer Operator; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of his recent accomplishment and continued hard work, Council for the Village of Thornville wants to increase Corey Hoover's hourly rate.

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: Council for the Village of Thornville hereby increases Corey Hoover's hourly rate of pay to \$18.11/hr. This new hourly rate shall take effect on the day Mr. Hoover obtained his Waste Water I License, November 19, 2018. The Village will make up this, now-owed backpay.

SECTION 2: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent part thereof.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that Council wants this pay raise to take effect as soon as possible. Wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council.
