

ORDINANCE 20-09

ADOPTED ON June 22, 2020

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO ADVERTISE BIDS FOR THE 2021-2023 RESIDENTIAL REFUSE HAULING CONTRACT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Thornville's current contract for residential refuse collection and disposal expires on December 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville would like to enter into another three (3) year exclusive contracts for residential refuse collection and disposal, commencing on January 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Thornville created the Village of Thornville Residential Refuse Hauling Bid Package January 1, 2021-December 31, 2023 to assist prospective bidders; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville would like qualified persons firms, or corporations to submit sealed bids to collect, transport, and dispose of all garbage, trash, refuse, and yard waste from all residential property located within the Village of Thornville.

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: Council for the Village of Thornville hereby authorizes and directs the Village Administrator, or her designee, to advertise for bids to collect, transport, and dispose of all garbage, trash, refuse and yard waste from all residential property located within the Village of Thornville, for not less than two nor more than four consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the Village in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 7.16. The bids shall be opened and publicly read by the Village Administrator, or her designee, at the time, date and place as specified in the advertisement to bidder or specifications.

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

SECTION 4: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and further reason that the Village wants to advertise, collect bids and award this contract as soon as possible. Wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the required affirmative votes of Council, it shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage of Council.
