WHEREAS, in July 2007, the Village of Thornville and Perry County executed an agreement whereby the Village would provide Perry County potable water. Over the past few years, the Village and the County have been discussing the terms of a new potable water contract; and

its own permanent County-owned and -maintained potable water system; and WHEREAS, Perry County still wants to obtain potable water from the Village until it can develop

contract with Perry County. WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville would like to enter into a new, five-year water

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

- SECTION 1: The Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to execute a Water Contract, in substantially the same form and content as the Contract attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, with
- SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning that results in such formal action were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio. Council, and that any and all deliberation of this Council and any of its committee and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in open meeting of this
- SECTION 3: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts hereof.
- SECTION 4: upon passage by Council. affirmative votes of Council, it shall take effect and be in full force immediately as soon as possible. Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the further reason that the Village needs to enter into this agreement, with its new rates, preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the Wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the required


