

ORDINANCE 25-02  
ADOPTED 1-13-2025

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND REVISING SPECIFIC LINE-ITEMS IN THE APPROPRIATIONS OF EXPENDITURES FOR THE VILLAGE OF THORVILLE FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2024 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Thornville, Ohio, is authorized to adopt the Municipal Budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2024, and ending December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, with Ordinance 23-09, Council for the Village of Thornville established the Village's annual appropriations for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, with Ordinance 24-07 and Ordinance 24-10, Council for the Village of Thornville made subsequent amendments to the annual appropriations for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer has recommended amending the appropriations to supplement those appropriations previously adopted by Council.

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: Appropriations in the Street Fund (2011) as follows:

SECTION 5: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Thornville and the further reason that Council needs to provide the necessary funds to meet requirements and obligations. Wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council.
