

ordinance no. <u>25-17</u> adopted <u>August II, 2025</u>

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 96-19 AND THEREBY PROHIBIT PARKING ON THE EAST AND WEST SIDES OF CHURCH STREET

WHEREAS, with Ordinance 96-19, adopted on October 14, 1996, Council for the Village of Thornville created and established the following no parking zone on the west side of Church Street:

- from Columbus Street (SR 204) to the first alley south of the corner of Columbus Street and Church Street and
- from the second alley south of the corner of Columbus Street and Church Street to South Street; and

WHEREAS, recently residents have been trying to park in this general area, but on the east side of Church Street. However, the Chief of Police believes there is not enough room to park on the street, in this area, without causing a problem for pedestrian and/or vehicle traffic to pass safely; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville now wants to expand this No Parking Zone to the east side of Church Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council for the Village of Thornville, Perry County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: Section 1 of Ordinance 96-19, adopted on October 14, 2025, shall be amended to read as follows:

A No Parking Zone be, and the same hereby is, established on the east and west sides of Church Street in the following areas:

- from Columbus Street (SR 204) to the first alley south of the corner of Columbus Street and Church Street and
- from the second alley south of the corner of Columbus Street and Church Street to South Street; and
- SECTION 2: All other Sections of Ordinance 96-19 shall remain unchanged, in effect, valid, and enforceable.
- SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberation of this Council and any of its committee that results in such formal action were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
