AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND REVISING SPECIFIC LINE-ITEMS IN THE APPROPRIATIONS OF EXPENDITURES FOR THE VILLAGE OF THORNVILLE FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2025 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Thornville is authorized to adopt the Municipal Budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2025 and ending December 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, with Ordinance 24-19, adopted on December 16, 2024 Council for the Village of Thornville established the Village's annual appropriations for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2025. As noted below, the Water Improvement Fund had no funds previously appropriated to it because it did not exist; and

WHEREAS contemporaneous with this ordinance, Council for the Village of Thornville is creating the Water Improvement Fund (5701); and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer recommended amending the appropriations to supplement those appropriations previously adopted by Council.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: Appropriations in the Water Operating Fund (5101) as follows:

SECTION 3: All other original and amended sections and sub-sections of Ordinance 24-19 shall remain unchanged, in effect, and enforceable.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberation of this Council and any of its committee that results in such formal action were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 5: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Thornville and the further reason that Council needs to provide the necessary funds to meet requirements and obligations. Wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council.
