

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2026 MUNICIPAL BUDGET AND DIRECTING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO APPLY FOR AN AMENDED CERTIFICATE FOR THE VILLAGE OF THORNVILLE FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2026 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, in November 2025, Council for the Village of Thornville adopted a municipal budget for the fiscal year beginning on January 1, 2026 and ending on December 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, since adopting the FY 2026 Municipal Budget, Council for the Village of Thornville learned the Village must post receipts from the Sewer Lining Project. While this money goes directly to the contractor, the Village must track and record the money coming into the Village from the OPWC and then being paid to the contractor. This will be accomplished in Fund 5201 (Sewer) and Fund 5702 (WasteWater Improvement); and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer recommends increasing the municipal budget and applying for an amended certificate of estimated resources previously adopted by Council affective retroactively March 23, 2026.

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: As of March 23, 2026, appropriations in the WasteWater Improvement Fund (5702) and the Sewer Fund (5201) shall be as follows:

SECTION 2: The Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to certify the anticipated revenue increase listed in Section 1 and request an Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberation of this Council and any of its committee that results in such formal action were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

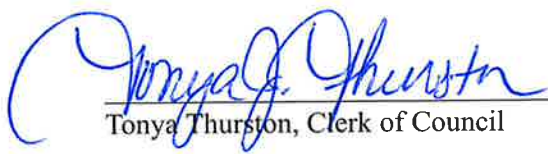

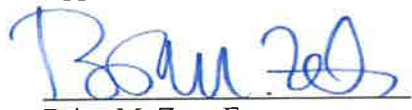
