

ORDINANCE NO. 16-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 15-09 (THE 2016 ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE), REVISING SUMS FOR OPERATING EXPENSES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Thornville is authorized to adopt the municipal budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2016 and ending December 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, with Ordinance 15-09, adopted October 26, 2015, Council for the Village of Thornville established the Village's annual appropriation for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer as recommended amending the appropriations to supplement those appropriation previously adopted by Council.

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: The 2016 Annual Appropriation of the Village of Thornville, as established by Ordinance 15-09, shall hereby be amended and additional amounts shall be appropriated, as recommended by the Fiscal Officer, as follows:

SECTION 2: All other original and amended sections and sub-section of Ordinance 15-09 shall remain unchanged, in effect, and enforceable.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

SECTION 5: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that Council needs to provide the necessary funds to meet requirements and obligations. Wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the required affirmative votes of Council, it shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage.
