

ORDINANCE NO. 20-16

ADOPTED ON: March 22 2021

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND CONFIRMING WILLOW WAY COURT AS A PUBLIC STREET FOR PUBLIC MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION BY THE VILLAGE OF THORNVILLE

WHEREAS, pursuant to R.C. 723.03, a street or alley, dedicated to public use by the proprietor of ground in any municipal corporation, shall not be a public street or alley, or under the care or control of the legislative authority of such municipal corporation, unless the dedication is accepted and confirmed by an ordinance specially passed for such purpose; and

WHEREAS, Daniel Grosse and Ashley Grosse previously surveyed and platted, in the Perry County Plat Records, the right-of-way of Willow Way Court (60' wide RW) as shown on the Plat of Deer Trail Estates, as recorded in Plat Book 5, Pages 509 – 514; and

WHEREAS, Ashley and Daniel Grosse built Willow Way Court and now want it accepted and dedicated as a public street, consistent with the Deer Trail Estates Plat; and

WHEREAS, acceptance and confirmation of the Willow Way Court is consistent with the public interest of the Village of Thornville and its residents.

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: Willow Way Court, as set forth on Deer Trail Estates Plat, is hereby formally accepted and confirmed for public maintenance and operation by the Village of Thornville.

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberation of this Council and any of its committee that results in such formal action were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts hereof.


SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
