

ORDINANCE #20-17

ADOPTED ON: October 21, 2020

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO ADVERTISE BIDS TO CONVERT THE THORNVILLE POOL FILTRATION SYSTEM TO A PRESSURE SAND FILTER SYSTEM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville would like to convert the current existing Thornville Pool DE Filtration System to a Pressure Sand Filter System; and.

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville reasonably anticipates the cost of this improvement will cost more than \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to R.C. 731.141, Council for the Village of Thornville now wants to advertise for bids for the improvements to the Thornville Pool filtration system.

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:


SECTION 1: Council for the Village of Thornville hereby authorizes and directs the Village Administrator, or her designee, to advertise for bids to convert the current existing Thornville Pool DE Filtration system to a Pressure Sand Filter System for not less than two nor more than four consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the Village in accordance with R.C. 7.16. The bids shall be opened and publicly read by the Village Administrator, or her designee, at the time, date and place as specified in the advertisement to bidder or specifications.

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.


SECTION 4: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and further reason that the Village wants to advertise, collect bids and award this contract as soon as possible. Wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the required affirmative votes of Council, it shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage of Council.
