

ORDINANCE NO. 21-10

ADOPTED JUNE 28 2021

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING FUND NUMBER 2151 (American Rescue Plan Act) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Thornville recently applied for, and is awaiting receipt of funds from the American Rescue Plan Act for Infrastructure Improvements;

WHEREAS, R.C. 5705.14 allows the taxing authority of a political subdivision to establish, with the approval of and in the manner prescribed by the auditor of state, such funds as are desirable, and may provide by ordinance or resolution that money derived from specified sources other than the general property tax to be paid directly into such funds; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville needs to establish and create a new fund (American Rescue Plan Act Fund) in order to properly account for money the Village will receive from the American Rescue Plan Act.

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: Council for the Village of Thornville hereby creates and establishes the follow fund:

<u>Fund Number</u>	<u>Fund Title</u>
2151	American Rescue Plan Act Funds

SECTION 2: All money received from the ARPA will be deposited into Fund Number 2151, and the Village will use this Fund to pay expenses related to infrastructure improvements within the Village.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

SECTION 5: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that Council needs to create this new fund as soon as possible so that it can timely receive and spend money on the infrastructure improvements. Wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the required affirmative votes of Council, it shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage by Council.
