

ORDINANCE 24 -07  
ADOPTED JULY 22, 2024

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND REVISING THE 2024 APPROPRIATIONS OF THE VILLAGE OF THORNVILLE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Thornville, Ohio, is authorized to adopt the Municipal Budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2024, and ending December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, with Ordinance 23-09, Council for the Village of Thornville established the Village's annual appropriations for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer has recommended amending the appropriations to supplement those appropriations previously adopted by Council.

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: The 2024 Annual Appropriations of the Village of Thornville, as established by Ordinance 23-09, shall hereby be amended and additional amounts shall be appropriated, as recommended by the Fiscal Officer, as follows:

SECTION 2: All other original and amended sections and sub-sections of Ordinance 23-09 shall remain unchanged, in effect, and enforceable.



SECTION 5: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Thornville and the further reason that Council

needs to provide the necessary funds to meet requirements and obligations. Wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council.


