

RESOLUTION NO. 26-04

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO THE VILLAGE PARK BALL FIELD USE AGREEMENT WITH THE THORNVILLE YOUTH RECREATION ASSOCIATION FOR THE 2026 YOUTH BASEBALL SEASON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Thornville owns a park located at or near the intersection of Park Drive South and Veterans Memorial Drive, where, among other things, two baseball diamonds/fields are located; and

WHEREAS, for nearly a decade, the Thornville Youth Recreation Association (“TYRA”) has entered into an agreement with the Village of Thornville to use the two baseball diamonds/fields nearby facilities for the youth baseball season; and

WHEREAS, since the 2026 youth baseball season is right around the corner, TYRA wants to enter into another agreement to use the two baseball diamonds/fields, restrooms, and concession stands for its baseball games and tournaments; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville now wants to continue to support local athletes grant use of the two baseball diamonds/fields, restrooms, and concession stands for the 2026 youth baseball season.

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: Council for the Village of Thornville hereby authorizes and directs the Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer to enter into the Village Park Ball Field Use Agreement with the Thornville Youth Recreation Association, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2: Council for the Village of Thornville also hereby authorizes and directs the Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer to execute any other documentation that may be necessary to grant TYRA access to the two baseball diamond/fields, restrooms, and concession stands.

SECTION 3: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Resolution is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the Village of Thornville which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 5: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the

further reason that TYRA's 2026 youth baseball season begins in March. Wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council.
