A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE COSHOCTON-FAIRFIELD-LICKING-PERRY (CFLP)
SOLID WASTE DISTRICT'S UPDATED SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, on June 26, 2026, the Policy Committee of the Coshocton-Fairfield-Licking-Perry Solid Waste District (the "District") approved the updated Solid Waste Management Plan (the "Plan") based on its extensive review of the existing plan, comments received by OEPA, and public hearings held in all four respective counties of the District; and

WHEREAS, in order to change/update the Plan, the changes must be ratified by townships and municipalities representing 60% of the District's population, including at least three of the four largest municipalities in each county, and three of the four boards of county commissioners. Once ratified locally, the updated Plan will be sent to the Ohio EPA for its final review and approval; and

WHEREAS, the updated Plan now includes:

- ❖ Potential drop off collection expansion to service multi-family and commercial structures.
- ❖ Increased Promotion of the "Recycle Right Campaign" to minimize contamination and increase recycle volumes.
- ❖ A focus on positive lifestyle changes in rural, underrepresented, and underperforming areas.
- ❖ Increased enforcement of illegal dumping through the "Report a Dumper" program; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville now wants to formally ratify the updated Plan because it believes the Plan is in the best interest of health, safety, and welfare of Village residents.

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: Council for the Village of Thornville hereby ratifies the updated Coshocton-Fairfield-Licking-Perry Solid Waste District's Solid Waste Management Plan.

SECTION 2: The Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to mail or otherwise deliver a certified copy of this resolution to the Policy Committee no later than October 17, 2026 (90 days after the Village received notice).

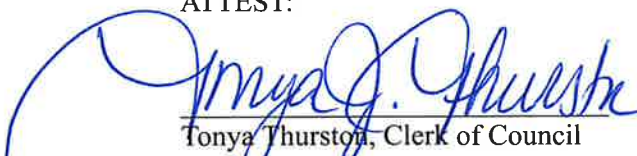
