A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION 23.STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) State Capital Improvement Program (SCIP) provides financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, over the past several weeks, the Village of Thornville has experienced considerable rainfall, resulting in widespread flooding throughout the Village and significant strain on the Village's wastewater and sewer facilities; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville believes it is necessary to upgrade the Village's wastewater and sewer facilities to prevent future flooding issues. The Village is eligible to apply for SCIP financial assistance to help fund this much needed infrastructure improvements project; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein described is a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs. The deadline for the Village of Thornville to submit the OPWC/SCIP financial assistance application is September 8, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville would like the Village Administrator, or his designee, to complete and submit the OPWC/SCIP financial assistance application for the Village's wastewater and sewer facilities improvements project.

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: The Village Administrator, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and submit an application, and any other necessary and related documents, to OPWC/SCIP for financial assistance for the Village of Thornville's wastewater and sewer facilities improvements project.

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Thornville and the further reason that the Village must submit the OPWC/SCIP financial assistance application by September 8, 2026, in order to receive funding for this much needed infrastructure improvements project, as more fully explained in the whereas clauses which are incorporated here by reference. Wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council.
