 12. Fiscal Officer's Report (presented during the 2nd meeting of the month)
- 13. Committee Reports (presented during the 2nd meeting of the month)
- 14. Zoning and Planning Commission Report (presented during the 1st meeting of the month)
- 15. Unfinished Business
- 16. New Business
- 17. Executive Session (if necessary)
- 18. Council Comments
- 19. Citizen Comments
- 20. Meeting Announcement
- 21. Adjournment
- SECTION 2: All other sections and sub-section of the Rules of Council shall remain unchanged, in effect, and enforceable.
- SECTION 3: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Resolution is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.
- SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.
- SECTION 5: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason Council would like to amend and follow this amended Rule as soon as possible. Wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the required affirmative

votes of Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council.
