

RESOLUTION NO. 14-005

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO A ²⁴CONTACT TO PURCHASE SODIUM CHLORIDE (ROCK SALT) FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE STREET DEPARTMENT FOR THE 2014-2015 WINTER SEASON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, R.C. 5513.01(B) provides the opportunity for political subdivisions of the state, including municipalities, to participate in contracts of the Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") for the purchase of machinery, material, supplies or other articles, which includes sodium chloride (rock salt); and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has recommended participation in the ODOT contract for the winter season of 2013–2014 for the purchase of rock salt for Village roadways and sidewalks as a cost savings to the Village.

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: Council for the Village of Thornville hereby authorizes and directs the Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer to execute an agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation, Cooperative Purchasing Program, in substantially the same form and content as the "Resolution/Ordinance" (agreement), attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, for participation in the ODOT contract for the purchase of sodium chloride (rock salt) for the Village's Street Department for the 2014-2015 summer and/or winter season and for the tonnage required.

SECTION 2: Council for the Village of Thornville hereby authorizes the Fiscal Officer to appropriate to a proper account the amount deemed necessary to cover the cost of the Agreement with ODOT authorized in Section.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Village of Thornville which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Resolution is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

SECTION 5: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that Village Council needs to execute this Agreement by April 8, 2014 in order to take advantage of this pricing. Wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
