The Council of the Village of Thornville, Perry County, Ohio met in Special Session on the 21th day of September, 2015, in Council Chambers of the Village of Thornville with the following member present:

Mr. MS HEIDI ROBINSON moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, this Council in accordance with the provisions of law has previously adopted a Tax Budget for the next succeeding fiscal year commencing January 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, This Budget Commission of Perry County, Ohio has certified its action thereon to this Council together with an estimate by the County Auditor of the rate of each tax necessary to be levied by this Council, and what part thereof is without, and what part within the ten mill tax limitation; therefore be it,

RESOLVED, By the Council of the Village of Thornville, Perry County, Ohio that the amounts and rates, as determined by the Budget Commission in its certification, be and the same are hereby accepted; and be it further

RESOLVED, That there be and is hereby levied on the tax duplicate of said Village the rate of each tax necessary to be levied within and without the ten mill limitation as follows:

* A copy of this Resolution must be certified to the County Auditor before the first day of October, or at such later date as may be approved by the Department of Taxation of Ohio as prescribed by Section 5705.34 R.C






