

RESOLUTION NO. 17-002

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF KIMBLE RECYCLING & DISPOSAL, INC. FOR CURBSIDE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF HOUSEHOLD REFUSE, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH KIMBLE RECYCLING & DISPOSAL, INC. FOR THE SAME, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the current contract for curbside collection and disposal of household refuse hauling in the Village of Thornville will expire on December 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, earlier this year, Council for the Village of Thornville authorized and directed the Village to advertise for bids for a new three year contract for refuse hauling; and

WHEREAS, Kimble Recycling & Disposal, Inc. submitted the lowest and best bid for said refuse hauling services.

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: Council for the Village of Thornville hereby accepts the bid of Kimble Recycling & Disposal, Inc. for curbside collection and disposal of household refuse hauling in the Village of Thornville.

SECTION 2: The Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer and hereby authorized and directed, on the behalf of the Village of Thornville, to enter into an agreement with Kimble Recycling & Disposal, Inc., in substantially the same form and content as the contact attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, for the curbside collection and disposal of household refuse.

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.


SECTION 3: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Resolution is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

SECTION 4: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that the Village wants to award this contract as soon as possible. Wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the required affirmative votes of Council, it shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage of Council.
