A RESOLUTION CONCURRING WITH THE MAYOR'S FINAL APPOINTMENT OF DANIEL T. WILLIAMS AS THE FULL-TIME POLICE CHIEF FOR THE VILLAGE OF THORNVILLE, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, with Ordinance 20-02, adopted on January 27, 2020, Council for the Village of Thornville confirmed, pursuant to R.C. 737.15, the Mayor's initial appointment of Dan Williams as the full-time Police Chief for the Village of Thornville; and

WHEREAS, Dan Williams has satisfactorily and continuously served a six-month probationary period, as required by R.C. 737.17; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor recently transmitted to Council for the Village of Thornville a record of Dan Williams's service with his recommendation that Chief Williams be finally appointed as the full-time Chief of Police with the Village of Thornville Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville believes Dan Williams has done a remarkable job, is an asset to the community, and it is in the Village's best interest to concur with the Mayor's final appointment of Dan Williams.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio

- SECTION 1: Pursuant to R.C. 737.17, Council for the Village of Thornville hereby concurs with the Mayor's final appointment of Daniel T. Williams as the full-time Chief of Police with the Village of Thornville Police Department.
- SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.
- SECTION 3: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Resolution is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereto.
- SECTION 4: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that Council want to concur immediately with this final appointment so that Dan Williams can have the job security that comes with this final appointment. Wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the required affirmative votes of Council, it shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage by Council.
