

RESOLUTION NO. 25-01

ADOPTED ON: 3-10-2025

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO EXECUTE A CUSTOMER AGREEMENT WITH iamGIS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, iamGIS is an all-in-one software solution built to meet the needs of customers of all sizes. Its customers are provided with access to the iamGIS web-based mapping, asset management, work order, and facilities management software platform. The software platform enables users to digitally track and manage their infrastructure, streamline task management and work orders, and pull all data and reports needed to run their operations; and

WHEREAS, iamGIS works with over 260 organizations across 36 states. Its customers range from a few hundred in population to others serving over 125,000 residents; and

WHEREAS, iamGIS proposed a 36-month agreement at a cost of \$4,000.00/yr. There also is a 1-time implementation fee of \$1,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville believes the iamGIS software will help many of its departments, such as Water, Sewer, Storm Sewer, and Streets.

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: Council for the Village of Thornville hereby authorizes and directs the Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer to execute a Customer Agreement, in substantially the same form and content as the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, with iamGIS.

SECTION 2: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Resolution is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the Village and the further reason that the Village needs to enter into this Agreement as soon as possible so because the price quote will expire on March 14, 2025. Wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council.
