

RESOLUTION NO. 25-22

ADOPTED 9/11/25

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT THE BID OF, AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH, VISU SEWER OF OHIO LLC AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, with Resolution 25-09, adopted on May 27, 2025, Council for the Village of Thornville authorized ADR & Associates Ltd to advertise, accept, and review bids for the WWTP Improvements: Phase II Infiltration and Inflow Reduction Project (aka Thornville Sanitary Sewer Lining Project); and

WHEREAS, the Village received six bids; and

WHEREAS ADR& Associates Ltd. reviewed these bids and believes Visu Sewer of Ohio LLC's bid is the lowest and best bid; and

WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Thornville recognizes the need to enter into contract with the lowest and best bidder and believes Visu Sewer of Ohio LLC's bid meets this criterion.

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council for the Village of Thornville, Perry County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: Council for the Village of Thornville hereby authorizes and directs the Village Administrator to accept the bid of Visu Sewer of Ohio LLC.

SECTION 2: Council for the Villag of Thornville hereby authorizes and directs the Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer to execute an agreement with Visu Sewer of Ohio LLC to complete the WWTP Improvements: Phase II Infiltration and Inflow Reduction Project at a cost not to exceed \$1,571,3000.00.

SECTION 3: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Resolution is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent part thereof.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meeting in open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 5: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the Village and the further reason that the Village needs to start and complete this project as soon as possible. Wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council.

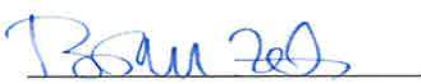
