

RESOLUTION 10-08

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF THORNVILLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED.

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Thornville is planning to make capital improvements to its street and roadway system; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs.




SECTION 1: The Mayor and Village Administrator are hereby authorized to apply to the Ohio Public Works Commission for funds to make capital improvements to its street and roadway system as described above.

SECTION 2: The Mayor, Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer are further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
